These horrific acts of senseless violence are the epitome of an inhumane crisis in our country. There have already been 220 mass shootings in 2022. The standard condolence that our "thoughts and prayers are with you" sounds like hollow brass because Democratic women want action, policies, and the change that can end these horrifying and grim actions.

NFDW has previously passed resolutions aimed at expressly protecting children and ending random violence has been our priority.
