## National Federation of Democratic Women Resolution in Support of Gun Safety Legislation

WHEREAS, more American children have been killed with guns between January 1 and May 18, 2018, while attending their public schools than American soldiers have died in American military actions during the same period (*Washington Post, May 18, 2018; wapo.st/2rTOJ8B*); and

**WHEREAS,** we, the women of NFDW do not believe that more guns are the solution to deaths by guns;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** we encourage our membership, our political party, and our Nation to work steadfastly and with all available resources to:

- Institute a viable, credible, legislatively required system of background checks on all gun purchases, wherever the purchase may be made;
- Prohibit the sale of firearms to children under the voting age;
- Pass legislation to hold parents fully legally, responsible for the use of a
  firearm by a minor child that results in the death or injury of that child or
  another human being due to an unsecured firearm kept in the home; and
- Ban, through Federal legislation, assault weapons, bump stocks, and highcapacity magazines in the hands of citizens other than law enforcement officials and the military.
