Statehood.

Join advocates around the country by peacefully gathering and demand that Congress act. Let the world hear your voices. Send out press releases and invite the press to your activities. Write editorials and letters to the editor. Rev up your active campaign tactics.

You should also be aware that on Saturday, August 28 March on for Voting Rights in Washington D.C. will take place, and this peaceful protest will demand that legislatures across the country end their push for restricting voting laws, and that Congress pass the For the People Act and the John Lewis Voting Rights Restoration Act.
